A. Ordinance 2023-490 – introduction ORDINANCE 2023-490 AN ORDINANCE TO ESTABLISH A HANDICAPPED PARKING SPACE ON-STREET IN THE VILLAGE OF LOCH ARBOUR, COUNTY OF MONMOUTH

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Commissioners of the Village of Loch Arbour, in the County of Monmouth and State of New Jersey, as follows:

Section 1. Pursuant to the authority granted to the Village of Loch Arbour by N.J.S.A 39:4-197.6, the following location is hereby designated as a restricted parking space for use by the handicapped person residing in the premises known as Block 9, Lot 1, 114 Euclid Avenue, Loch Arbour, New Jersey, to whom a windshield placard or wheelchair symbol license plates have been issued by the Division of Motor Vehicles for a vehicle owned by the handicapped person or another occupant of the residence who is a member of the immediate family of the handicapped person. No other persons shall be permitted to park in this space.

PROPERTY ADDRESS: Block 9, Lot 1, 114 Euclid Avenue, Loch Arbour, New Jersey.

Section 2. In addition to any other penalty provided by New Jersey Statute, any unoccupied vehicle parked or standing in violation of this Ordinance shall be deemed a nuisance and menace to the safe and proper regulation of traffic and any police officer may provide for the removal of such vehicle. The owner shall pay the reasonable costs of the removal and storage, which may result from such removal before regaining possession of the vehicle.

Section 3. All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances, which are inconsistent herewith, are hereby repealed, but only to the extent of such inconsistency.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its final passage and publication as required by law.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of the Village of Loch Arbour, that the Lease between the Tenant and Landlord be terminated for the violations of said terms and conditions, that include, but are not limited, the following:

- Discrimination
- Unauthorized Sub-Lease
- Failure to open kitchen area on Saturdays throughout the 2023 Summer Season
- Unauthorized alterations to the demised premises, which led to significant fines assessed by the Borough of Deal Construction Department for the lack of obtaining building permits.
- Impermissible surcharges to patrons.
- Refusing to close due to inclement weather, as directed by the Beach Manager.
