## ORDINANCE #2017-431

## AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE NO. 2017-424, ENTITLED "HISTORIC PRESERVATION ORDINANCE"

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Commissioners of the Village of Loch Arbour, in the County of Monmouth and State of New Jersey, that the Ordinance referred to in the title hereof is amended and supplemented as follows:

Section 6. New subsection 6.4, entitled Fees, is hereby added as follows:

6.4 Fees

- A. Application fee for a Certificate of Appropriateness: \$50.00
- B. All applications for a Certificate of Appropriateness shall be accompanied by a \$300,00 deposit for professional fees to be held in escrow and disbursed as necessary. Any balance remaining upon completion and final approval shall be refurned to the applicant, Should any additional amount be required for professional services, the applicant shall replenish the escrow amount

This Ordinance shall become effective twenty days after its final passage and publication as required by law.
