ORDINANCE #2018-448

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE NO. 156
AMENDING AND SUPPLEMENTING THE PORCH
LIMITATIONS IN RESIDENTIAL DISTRICTS FOR THE
VILLAGE OF LOCH ARBOUR, IN THE COUNTY OF
MONMOUTH, STATE OF NEW JERSEY

BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Commissioners of the Village of Loch Arbour, in the County of Monmouth and the State of New Jersey, that the Ordinance referred to in the title hereof is amended and supplemented as follows:

Section 1. Section 302, Article 3, (definitions):

Porch shall mean a veranda or raised level platform with open sides, with a roof, projecting out from a main exterior wall of a building and used as an entrance way and/or for sitting or lounging out of doors, and shall be required on all residential dwellings. Minimum porch dimensions shall be a length of at least 50% of the width of the dwelling and a depth of at least 8 feet in the front yard. Porches shall be located in the front yard and may wrap round to a side yard and must comply with the front and side yard setback requirements of the principal building.

Section 2. All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances which are inconsistent herewith are repealed, but only to the extent of such inconsistency.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its final passage and publication as required by law.
